

Arlington Township
Regular Meeting Minutes
May 17, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.. Board members present were Phillippe, Pitts, Pugsley, DeLeo and Melvin.

The minutes of the April 19, 2017 meeting were read. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to approve as read. Motion Carried.

Police Report-- Jason reported that there were 29 calls in the township, 6 of which were assaults.

Fire Report--Bangor-- It was reported that the Fire Board Budget had been adopted. The new rescue truck should be here by the 1st of next week. There will be a pancake breakfast on the 27th from 7am til 11 am. The department is receiving donations for the July 4th fireworks display. There were 42 calls last month bringing the year to date total to 172 calls. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to approve the 2017 Fireworks contract with the department in the amount of \$500.00. All members voted yes. Motion Passed.

Road Commission-- SW Michigan Dust Control will salt township roads mid June with a second application later in the summer.

Ambulance Report-- Response times are averaging 9 mins. 48 seconds.

Commissioner's Report-- John Faul will again become the County Administrator.

Seniors Report-- Food trucks will run again this year. Lots of events are planned for summer and fall.

Planning Commission Report-- At its next meeting the commission will take action on 4 existing Special Use Permits. Still awaiting a draft of the new Master Plan.

Enforcement Officer Report-- Mr. Bixler is still a no-show for court appearances. Mr. Letten's court date has been set for July 14th. Burkharts court date will be July 16th. No contact with Puckett yet.

Clerk Report-- Pugsley reported on the May election results. Also noted that new voting equipment will be here by fall.

Supervisor Report-- Jacque will not be able to attend future SW Mi. Planning Commission meetings because of her new job.

Treasurer's Report-- Motion by DeLeo supported by Pitts to pay the bills. All member voted yes. Motion Carried. The motion also allowed phil to pay Republic for dumpsters and \$500.00 for the Bangor Fire Department fireworks donation, plus \$4227.50 down payment for transfer station fence construction.

New Business-- The 425 agreement with Bangor City has been formally dissolved by both Boards. The fence quotation from shugars for the transfer station fence was \$8455.00. Motion by Pitts supported by Melvin to accept this quote. All members voted yes. The motion is carried.

A bid from Building Restoration was received to clean and repaint the township hall with the same material as was used last time in the amount of \$10,043.00.

Motion by DeLeo supported by Melvin to hire Keith Mann to remove a tree in Hicks cemetery pending proper insurance coverage in the amount of \$600.00. All members voted yes. Motion Carried.
