

Arlington Township
Regular Meeting Minutes
June 21, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Board members present were Phillippe, Pitts Pugsley, DeLeo and Melvin.

The minutes of the May 17, 2017 meeting were read. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to adopt the minutes as read. Motion Carried.

Police Report-- There were 45 calls last month.

Fire Report-- Bangor, There were 15 calls. The rescue truck is done.

Road Commission-- the commission is selling furniture. Contact the office if interested.

Ambulance Report-- there were 21 calls with an average response time of 7 minutes 18 seconds.

Commissioner Report-- Kurt reported that a new state law requires that all indigent people be furnished attorneys hired by the County. Election equipment has been ordered at a cost of \$595.00 per voting machine.

Senior Report-- Food trucks will be in the area again this year. Check Senior newspaper for dates and locations. The operation in Paw Paw will be moving to Freshwater Church in October.

Planning Commission-- The planning commission recommended that all Special Use Permits currently in place be renewed by the Board. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to approve the renewals. Motion Carried

A discussion about looking more into Marijuana licensing and distribution ensued. The Board felt that at this time Arlington Township was not interested in pursuing the matter further.

Assessor Report-- the July Board of Review will be held on July 18th.

Enforcement Report-- John reported that Burkhart on 48th St was fined and ordered to clean up the property within 30 days by the court. It has been suggested that a dangerous building format be put together for the inspectors and enforcement officer.

Supervisors Report-- Keith Mann removed the cemetery tree and also had the stump ground out for an additional \$75.00. Motion to pay Mann the additional \$75.00 by Pitts supported by Phillippe. All members voted yes.

There will be a tire pickup in Paw Paw on June 22, 2017.

Treasurer Report-- Summer taxes will be going out soon. The treasurer's laptop is starting to go bad and may need to be replaced. If so DeLeo moved to replace the unit at a cost up to \$1000.00 supported by Melvin. All members voted yes.

Motion by Pugsley supported by DeLeo to pay the bills. All members voted yes.
