Commissioner Report-- The County is going for an \$80,000.00 grant to hire attorneys for the indigent.

Seniors Report-- Lots of things going on. Special Trip to Ireland is planned. A millage renewal is coming up.

Assessor Report-- Board of Revue on 7-18 went well. Several items were fixed. The follow-up to last year's audit also went well according to Hal.

Ordinance Report-- Bixler was fined \$250.00. Letten Hearing was post-poned due to medical issues.
