Regular Meeting Minutes
November 15, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Supervisor, Jacque Phillippe. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, DeLeo, and Melvin.

Motion by Pitts supported by Melvin to approve the October 18, 2017 minutes as corrected. Motion Carried.

Police Report-- There were 51 calls in the township,

Public Comment-- The Aldags updated the board on their new enterprise.

Ordinance Officer Report-- Brian Knotek presented a report to the board. Under blight prosecutions he reported that Bixler had been fined and the property cleaned up. Burkhardt was issued a court order to clean up property. The township will solicit bids to clean up the blight. Letten was ordered by the court to remove cars from his property by 12/22/2017. New ordinance language was given to the board to consider in order to streamline the township blight ordinance. The board was reminded that if it were to participate in the Medical Marijuana Dispensary program it must hold a special meeting to approve an opt-in to the program.

Supervisor Report-- Jacque reported that rumors that Arlington Township has passed a resolution opting into the MMD program was false.

Treasurer Report-- Phil presented the board with Budget Amendment #1 in the amount

of \$11,711.60. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to adopt the ammendment., All members voting in the affirmative the motion was adopted.

Motion by Pugsley supported by DeLeo to pay the bills. All members voted yes . The motion was approved.
