

Arlington Township
Regular Meeting Minutes
June 20, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Board members present were Pitts, Pugsley, Phillippe, DeLeo and Melvin.

The minutes of the May 16, 2018 meeting were read. Motion by Pitts supported by DeLeo to approve the minutes as read. Motion Carried

Police Report-- there were 63 police related calls last month. Jason reported that Van Buren Animal Control is not actively checking dogs for licenses. He reminded the Board that there is a millage renewal proposal for Public Safety Funding on the August Ballot.

Fire Report-- Bangor-- there were (7) calls in the township. July 4th fireworks will take place at the high school at 10:30 p.m.

Road Commission Report-- A quote from the road commission in the amount of \$127,000.00 has been received to do prep work on the 50th St project. Motion by Pitts supported by Pugsley to limit the amount of money the township will spend on this project to \$100,000.00 for this year. All members voted yes. The motion was passed.

Ambulance Report-- Jacque read a brief report from the ambulance company on last month's activity.

Commissioner Report-- The Under Sheriff, Chad Hunt has graduated from KVCC Police School. The roof on the old Sheriff's house is to be repaired. An audit of the county reported that its fund balance is more than adequate.

Assessors Report-- The July Board of Review will take place on 7-17-2018.

Planning Commission Report-- At its meeting on June 6, 2018 the commission recommended to the Board that it approve all four existing Special Use Permit holders for another year. The holders were: Krugger, Smith Excavating, Engle Farms, and the small engine repair facility next to the township hall. Motion by Pitts supported by Melvin to approve all four special use permits for another year. Motion Carried.

Enforcement Officer Report-- John gave a brief report on his activities.

Attorney Report-- Brian presented the Board with a resolution covering fee schedules for the Medical Marijuana Ordinance. Motion by Pugsley supported by Pitts to approve the resolution. All members voted yes. Motion carried.

Clerk Report-- Election Inspector training has been scheduled for the upcoming state primary election.

Supervisor Report-- A new Library Agreement will be needed by January of 2019. On a Ride-a-long with the Road Commission Jacque reported that CR 376 is very bad Jacque is working on a new website for the township.

Treasurer's Report-- Motion by DeLeo supported by Melvin to pay the bills. All members voted yes. Motion carried. Summer tax bills will go out on July 1st. Krohn Excavating has submitted a quote in the amount of \$17,250.00 to finish grading and filling low spots at the transfer station. This was tabled until the next meeting.
